2011 Charlie May Simon and Diamond Book Award Winners



CHARLIE MAY SIMON CHILDREN'S BOOK AWARD




SWINDLE by Gordon Korman is the winner of the 2010-2011 Charlie May Simon Children's Book Award. It was published by Scholastic in 2008.

LOST AND FOUND by Andrew Clements is the Honor Book for 2010-2011. It was published by Athenuem, a division of Simon & Schuster, in 2008.




ARKANSAS DIAMOND PRIMARY BOOK AWARD
